

## Dear Parents,

It is a pleasure to have your child/children in Storehouse Kids. As our ministry aims to better serve your family, we would like to give you the following reminders:

- 1. To protect others from getting sick, please do not bring your child/children to Storehouse Kids if they have been sick within at least 24 hours of service time. This includes having the following symptoms: runny nose (e.g., green and/or yellow mucus), pink eye, sore throat, cough, fever of 100°F or higher, recent flu, strep throat, diarrhea, vomiting, and/or rash. We encourage parents to keep children in sanctuary if they appear to have these or any other suspected contagious condition. Please allow your child to have been free of symptoms for at least 24 hours.
- 2. Please let us know of any allergies or dietary restrictions your child/children have. We do provide snacks (e.g., animal crackers, fruit juice/gummies, water, rice krispies, etc) for children from Preschool to 6th grade.
- 3. Please inform us of where your child is (or children are) along in their toilet training. We ask that you also bring a change of clothes (underwear, pull-ups, shorts, socks, etc) in the event of an accident.
- 4. Please label your child's/children's belongings, including bottles, sippy cups, formula, diaper bag, etc.)
- 5. Please avoid having your child bring toys from home. We cannot be responsible for lost or broken toys.
- 6. In order to speed up the check-in process, please have your key tags ready. If you do not have one, please ask a Storehouse Kids check-in volunteer and/or leader to provide one.
- 7. Please patiently wait at kiosks upon check-in and pick-up, so that you can be guided by a Storehouse Kids volunteer or leader to your child's class. This allows for smoother traffic upon children's arrival and dismissal of each class. Ultimately, this is to ensure the safety of all children in the care of Storehouse Kids.
