Who Does Discipleship Begin With?

 \rightarrow Discipleship begins with knowing God;

 \rightarrow Knowing God means that we are growing, maturing, valuing, and delighting in the depth of God through discipleship;

 \rightarrow Therefore, discipleship is all about our reorientation toward the beauty and splendor of the God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

What is A Disciple of Jesus? 1. One who is sent by Jesus;

- 2. One who is a new creation in Jesus;
- 3. One who teaches the things of Jesus;
- 4. One who obeys Jesus;
- 5. One who embraces the promises of Jesus

What Does Discipleship Look Like?

- 1. Discipleship is and happens in the ordinary;
- 2. Discipleship is intentional (knowing God and making Him known);
