Our Deepest Desire

- 1. One thing
 - a. "Let all our affections be bound up in one affection and that affection set upon heavenly things." (Charles Spurgeon)
 - b. "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth." (Colossians 3:1-2)

Our Deepest Experience

- 1. Dwelling in the presence of the Lord
 - a. "Hear O Lord, when I cry aloud: be gracious to me and answer me! You have said, 'Seek my face.' My heart says to you, 'Your face, Lord, do I seek.'" (Psalm 27:7-8)
 - b. "It was not the earthly temple itself that charmed David, but rather the beauty of the Lord that was to be found at the temple in a special way. It is the Lord himself that he is seeking." (James Boice)

 - a. "Holy desires must lead to resolute action." (Charles Spurgeon)
