Biblical Lament is not:

- Self-perpetuating
- A distraction
- Shameful

Main idea:

To lament is to follow the heart of God

Two truths about lament:

1) Lament is a beautiful paradox.

Lament is the path we walk between suffering and grace.

2) Lament is intensely honest.
